




### **Beyond the Book**







## Celebrating Birthdays with Joy at Howard Public School

At Howard Public School, every child is special—and so is their birthday! To make our students feel cherished, we celebrate each birthday with joy and enthusiasm.



These simple yet heartfelt gestures help create lasting memories for our students and remind them that they are an important part of the Howard family












































## బోనాలు


CENBOSEC serves as a dynamic platform for students and educators to share innovative pedagogical ideas and stay informed about the latest initiatives and updates from the Board.


During the month of July, several significant days were observed through informative write-ups, drawings, posters, and slogans prepared by the students:


#### **Role of Student Behaviour**

#### Howard Public School – 19th July, Saturday


